

# Nexus 5001™ Membership Form and Agreement

Please complete and submit an original signed copy of this Membership Form and Agreement along with the appropriate membership fee to the IEEE-ISTO. Membership rights and privileges will commence upon confirmation from the IEEE-ISTO that the agreement and payment in full have been received. The Nexus5001™ Forum fiscal year is January 1 through December 31. New Members joining before July 1 shall pay the full annual fee for that year; new members joining on or after July 1 shall pay half of the full annual fee.

## 1. Membership Level (select one):

 Silicon Member (USD \$6,000): The Nexus 5001™ Forum defines a silicon vendor as any company that
manufactures silicon components and/or markets CPU intellectual property, microprocessor architectures
and/or CPU solutions based in silicon to other companies to be incorporated in end user applications. This would
include companies that manufacture CPU based solutions in silicon in a "foundry" based business model. The
Steering Committee of the Nexus 5001™ Forum shall serve as the final arbiter of whether, at the time of joining
the Forum, a company is a silicon vendor. Silicon Members have full participation rights in the Forum's
committees and entitlement to a seat on the Forum's Steering Committee.
Non-Silicon Member (USD \$2,500): Companies and organizations which do not meet the criteria of a Silicon
Member shall be considered Non-Silicon members. Non-Silicon Members have full participation rights in the
Forum's committees and entitlement to a seat on the Forum's Steering Committee.
Associate Member (USD \$250): Reserved for individuals from government organization who wish to participate
in the Forum's technical committees. Associated members must obtain sponsorship from a Silicon or Non-
Silicon member in good standing to be considered for membership.
 Educational Affiliate Member (No Fee): Reserved for individuals from educational institutions who wish to
participate in the Forum's technical committees. These participants must be approved by the Steering
Committee or sponsored by a Silicon or Non-silicon member in good standing to be considered for membership.
Primary contact must be a professor or paid employee from the institution. Additionally, a 100-word statement
must accompany this agreement that details prior work on Nexus and/or prior work with on-chip
instrumentation.
